Terms & Conditions

- The fund shall be open to members or a member's child* or spouse/civil partner.
- One application per member.
- One course/activity per applicant.
- The bursary shall pay for educational** or cultural activities certified by the appropriate body for **courses commenced in the period August 2018 to July 2019.**
- Bursaries are payable for course fees only and will not be paid to cover any ancillary costs i.e. books, living expenses, travel costs etc.
- The level of bursary payable to each eligible applicant will be determined by the number of applications received and the funds available to the Board of Directors in the current year.
- Applicants (excluding applications for members' children) must enclose with their application, **written confirmation of the amount of financial assistance provided by their employer, OR confirmation of non-payment of assistance.**
- Applicants must be members of the credit union for a period of 6 months prior to the closing date (31/07/19) and their credit union account must be in good standing during the relevant bursary period (1/08/18 –31/07/19).
- A minimum balance of €50 (excluding the €2.75 for prize draw) must be maintained in this account for a minimum of 6 months prior to the closing date of this fund. There must be a minimum of 1 transaction per month (not to include the prize draw) to the applicant's account
- A copy of a **Certified Receipt for payment of fees** must be submitted with application. Receipts will not be returned to members.
- The Board of Directors decision in all matters relating to this fund is final.
- Successful applicants will be sent a cheque in the post
- A bursary pot of €120,000 will be distributable among eligible applicants for fixed bursary amounts of 50 x €500, 200 x €250, with the rest being values of €100 and €50. The number of bursaries in each category will be determined by the number of applications received, surplus funds may increase the number of €500 & or €250 bursaries granted.
- The full €120,000 will be distributed in bursaries to eligible applicants.
- All bursary amounts will be granted on a lottery basis to eligible applicants
- No bursary will be issued for a value greater than the fees paid by the eligible applicant.
- No eligible applicant is guaranteed any specific amount based on the value of their course fees.
- The results of bursaries granted shall be made public including on the website www.hsscu.ie, and HSSCU's social media channels.
- An eligible applicant can only avail of one HSSCU bursary per annum
- Completed applications should be marked "Betty Noone Memorial Bursary" and returned to HSSCU, 5, High Street, Christchurch, Dublin 8, D08 X7T1

*If a child's two parents/guardians have accounts, both parents cannot apply for bursaries for the same child. Only one application will be accepted per student.

**Preschool fees, gym fees and private school (primary & secondary) fees are not included under educational activities.
