Bedroom Style Tips

Our bedrooms are cherished spaces, where we relax and renew. They set our mood for the day so the way we decorate and use this space really can improve our wellbeing.

Beautiful Bedding

We spend on average 7-9 hours a day in bed so it's important to allow ourselves luxurious fabrics and a good quality mattress and pillows. For bed linen ideally go for sheets that are 100 percent cotton or linen with high thread counts of 350 or more. The selection is endless so choose carefully as the bedding you choose sets the tone for the rest of the room. A block colour is best and add texture and pattern by layering cushions and a bed throw to add more luxury to your bed.

Colour

Calming neutral colours that help you sleep are best. Soothing shades of delicate colours such as soft whites and washed out pastel shades can offer us a restful night's sleep. Tie in your wall colour with other décor in the room such as cushions or a rug to give a cohesiveness.

Proportion and Symmetry

A correct balance and scale of furniture in your bedroom can help your bedroom look in proportion. Having everything aesthetically pleasing to the eye makes us feel good. If things are off balance it throws the eye and makes us uneasy! If you treat your bed as a centre point and create a mirror image on each side this will start you on the right track. Pick a correctly sized headboard or bedframe that will not look too small or too big for the room size.

Bedside Table

Pick one that has a useful drawer for storage to reduce clutter and if using a table lamp make sure the scale is right so it's not too wide taking up table space. A smaller chest of drawers can be used as a side table to maximise storage. Wood tables add a warmth and softness and metal and glass tables can give a real contemporary feel so it's worth putting thought into choosing the right style and material. And always makes sure the height is right for your bed!

Layer Lighting

The more sources of lighting the better, for practicality and mood. Being practical and choosing table lamps or wall lights that are dimmable can create a nice mood.

Candles

Beautiful scented candles can create a relaxing mood, help you destress and add décor to the room. A good quality natural candle, such as beeswax or soy can purify the air. Scents of Galway candles make absolutely beautiful candles and are made from essential oils.

Window Drapery

Selecting a good colour and texture fabric for your drapery will do wonders for your bedroom, not only framing your windows beautifully but helping you sleep. A luxurious full length curtain in an off white textured linen is a beautiful choice that will blend nicely with a lot of colours as well as making a statement.

Easy Ways To Make Your Home More Eco-Friendly

As we all know, it has never been more important to improve our home's green efficiency. While we are making steps in the right direction, we thought it would help to put together some quick tips on how you can make your home more eco-friendly.

- Switch all lightbulbs to energy efficient lights. You would be surprised how much more mileage you can get with energy efficient bulbs.
- Create a home compost bin.
- Upgrade appliances to energy efficient models - but ONLY when they need to be upgraded. A lot of energy goes into appliance production so don't switch for the sake of it.
- Get everyone their own, reusable water bottle. These are great to track water intake and save on one-time plastics.
- Turn off your lights and appliances. Often, people go for a walk while leaving the TV and lights on - don't!
- Support local food producers. This lessens air miles for your food and supports the local economy.
- Sign everyone up to HSSCU eStatements. Signing up for our eStatements will save on printing. You can do so by messaging us in your online account or by contacting us. Email info@hsscu.ie for help.
- Pay your bills online.
- Upgrading windows, insulation, etc. can be costly, but will save you money in the long-run.
- We are all guilty of purchasing items to try online because they're easily returned. This has a huge impact on the environment, so be mindful.
- Repurpose old towels and t-shirts as cleaning cloths.
- Keep your glass jars to repurpose as containers.

- Get more houseplants!
- Use natural cleaning alternatives to detergents. Fresh lemon juice is great for cleaning grills.
- Meatless Mondays. Start by introducing 1 day a week where you don't eat any meat or fish. This is easy to do and should you like it you can add in more down the line!
- Fit a smart thermostat. These save between 10-12% on heating and allow you to control your heating from your phone.
- Clean your fridge coils. This will help your fridge use less energy to keep your food cold.
- Water your plants with used water. For example, the water you used to wash your veggies!
- Get a low-flow shower head. You can still have a powerful shower, just with less water usage.
- Buy a good quality coffee maker and use coffee beans. This will make you less likely to get takeaway coffees and beans are far more environmentally friendly than pods.
