

The Women in Medicine in **Ireland Network (WiMIN)**

WiMin is a support organisation for

female doctors and medical students in Ireland, founded in 2017. Despite the majority of doctors in many specialities being female, there remain a number of areas of medicine where women are under-

represented, for example surgery, cardiology and rheumatology. There are also issues with gender pay gap and pension gap in medicine, as there are in all occupations. Women are under-represented in leadership positions in both academic and clinical medicine, and are often outnumbered by men on conference panels and in the media.

WiMIN was founded to support its members by highlighting these structural and societal inequalities and advocating for improved equity in representation. Our three successful national conferences have addressed issues such as the barriers facing LGBT+ people in medicine (both patients and doctors), the experiences of Muslim women in medicine, women's health in areas of conflict, and the emerging discipline of inclusion medicine, among many others. Our conferences offer free childcare and breastfeeding facilities, and we choose to decline sponsorship from pharmaceutical and formula companies. We are

delighted to have had the support of the HSSCU for our previous events, as their ethos matches ours so closely.

Each Sunday we honour a different doctor or medical student for their achievements, either personal or professional, in our #SundayWiMIN social media campaign. The nominees have included mountaineers, Olympians, innovators and pioneers, from the first Irish women to qualify as doctors to current-day medical students who have already achieved great success. We are always looking for nominees, so if you know of a woman in medicine who deserves to have their great work acknowledged, please get in touch!

Mentorship is well recognised for supporting young professionals to achieve their full potential and especially so for women. In 2020, WiMIN launched a small pilot mentorship programme which proved very successful. The launch of the full mentorship scheme has been stalled due to Covid, but we will be moving forward with it before the end of 2021.
