With our beehives, HSSCU are dedicated to supporting the endangered native Irish honeybee. In collaboration with Bee8, we have placed four beehives on the roof of our High Street offices, a conscious decision to contribute to the well-being of bees in our local community and enhance biodiversity in Dublin 8.

We have four beehives installed. This project aligns seamlessly with our ongoing commitment to sustainability and maximises the potential of our existing green living roof. Installing beehives was conceived through the Environmental Social and Governance (ESG) Committee and underscores our commitment to enhancing our positive environmental footprint. The collaboration with Bee8 has been fruitful, and we anticipate further development in this partnership.

At Bee8, they are on a mission to create a buzz around bee conservation while fostering community engagement. Our project, situated in the heart of Dublin, aims to support local bee populations, and raise awareness about the importance of pollinators in our ecosystem.

BEE8 PROJECT OVERVIEW:

Bee8 is a social enterprise managed by Robert Emmet Community Development Project. But Bee8 is more than just a beekeeping initiative; it's a symbol of community resilience and environmental stewardship. We've established 70 beehives across various community spaces, from rooftops to school campuses. These hives

not only provide a safe haven for bees but also serve as educational resources for local residents and students.

BEEKEEPER TIPS - HOW YOU CAN HELP BEES IN YOUR AREA

- Plant Bee-Friendly Flowers: Consider adding native wildflowers, such as lavender, sunflowers, and clover, to your garden or green spaces. These plants provide essential nectar and pollen for bees.
- Avoid Pesticides: Opt for natural pest control methods in your garden and refrain from using pesticides that can harm bees and other beneficial insects.
- Create Bee Habitats: Install bee hotels or nesting boxes in your garden to provide shelter for solitary bees and other pollinators.
- Support Local Beekeepers: Purchase honey from local beekeepers or support community beekeeping initiatives like Bee8 to help sustain bee populations in your

area.

By implementing these simple practices, you can play a vital role in supporting bee populations and promoting biodiversity in your community.

Following the enactment of the new Credit Union Amendment Act, HSSCU are hoping to send AGM notices to members via email as well as having related materials such as AGM booklets and accounts available for members online. If this happens, this will have a significantly positive environmental impact, as only a fraction of these regulatory documents would need to be printed. This would save on paper usage and energy consumption used to print and deliver these documents. It would also free up funds to go into other areas to continue to provide members with a high level of service. A physical copy of the documents can still be provided if required.

APP - USE BIOMETRICS EASIER ACCESS

Love Online Banking with HSSCU but struggle to remember your password or pin...

USE BIOMETRIC LOGIN INSTEAD!

Your account is at your fingertips. To login here you use your fingerprint to gain access. The biometric ID login enables access to our mobile and online banking users which allows you to access your account using the fingerprint reader on your smartphone or tablet. On apple devices like iPhones you can login with facial recognition.

Fast, safe and secure login.





WHAT IS OPEN BANKING?

Open Banking is a secure and safe way of enabling HSSCU to access your current account statements, if required as part of the loan application process with HSSCU.

As part of the loan application process you will be given the option to provide access to your bank statements. This can only be done with your express permission.

Access to your recent current account statements will enable the Lending team to assess your loan application more efficiently and speedily and eliminates the need for you to chase bank statements and email them to HSSCU.

HOW DOES IT WORK?


When you apply for a loan with us, you will be given an option to provide your bank statement to us electronically. This is done via an intermediary service called CRIF Realtime. To use this service, an email will be sent directly to you, during our phone call with you, seeking permission to access your bank account's transactions. To approve access to your account transactions you will be required to follow the link in the email and to select the bank you hold your current account in. You will be required to authenticate the process to access your bank account transactions by entering your banking online credentials or to approve the request in your banking app. Once this is completed CRIF Realtime will send HSSCU the requested bank statements on your current account. This removes the requirement for you to source your bank statement directly and helps us to reduce the time taken to process an application.

At no point do we ever see or have access to your banking passwords. Health Services Staffs Union cannot in any way affect your bank account.

OPEN MONDAYS FROM 10AM

We would like to remind members that as of Monday, 04/03/2024, all branches and services are now open at 10:00 am on Mondays.






At HSSCU your savings are an integral part of how we operate and provide our services. Whether you are saving for something specific like a house deposit or want to build a rainy, day fund, we can help.

Terms and conditions apply. AER is the Annual Equivalent Rate and shows what the interest rate would be if the interest was compounded and applied each year. Our AER calculation assumes that the account funds are held until maturity, the rate on maturity will be the prevailing nominal and variable rate on offer at that time. Interest is calculated on a 365-day basis. Terms of 12,24 and 36 months, minimum lodgement €5,000 and maximum of €90,000. Only one lump sum lodgement allowed for the term of the account. Deposit Interest Retention Tax (DIRT) is deducted from the interest earned on this account. Health Services Staffs Credit Union Ltd. is regulated by the Central Bank of Ireland.
